

## FXW Family Commitment to the Health and Safety of our Community

As a member of the FXW community, I am committed to keeping myself and the FXW community healthy and safe from the spread of COVID-19. During these extraordinary times, we are responsible for ourselves **and each other,** and we will work together to take the necessary steps to ensure the safety, health and well-being of everyone in our community.

We will abide by all health and safety directives from federal, state, and local officials and will encourage others to do the same. As we commit to a healthy and safe return to campus this fall, my family pledges to do our part so we can continue in-person instruction. We understand if we, or others, do not do our part, it is likely FXW will return to Learning off Campus. As a family committed to FXW, we vow to take the following actions:

- Encourage others to follow the guidelines spelled out by FXW and be willing to speak up when we see actions contrary to the expectations.
- Engage each morning in a daily "self-check" to monitor for the symptoms of COVID-19, and to contact FXW if my child has a fever of 100.4 F (38 C) or higher, dry cough, difficulty breathing, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell.
- Remind my child to wear a mask or face covering while on campus and in my neighborhood and community.
- Encourage and ask my child if they have washed their hands for at least 20 seconds regularly such as before they leave the house, at school throughout the day, and when they return home.
- Keep my child at home if sick or showing signs of illness.
- If necessary, follow isolation and/or quarantine protocols as directed by the Chicago Emergency Travel Order.
- Follow any new directives from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, *Restore Illinois*, *Be Safe. Chicago* or other government guidelines as they become available.
- Be caring, sensitive, and helpful to anyone who may be troubled or struggling with such concerns as health, academics, and personal matters.
- Support FXW in its enforcement of the guidelines
- Encourage others to follow these guidelines.

The safety of our community is a shared responsibility, and we acknowledge the actions of our family can put us and others at risk. We will all do our part to keep ourselves, our children, the FXW faculty and staff, and all FXW community members safe.
