For more than 25 years, the American Public Health Association (APHA) has organized NPHW. About 3,000 local health departments as well as

58 state and territorial health departments across the country join together to educate policymakers, practitioners and the community at-large about public health.

Our research and engagement with the community during the COVID-19 response and recovery revealed the public has limited understanding of the work we do and the resources and services we offer.

This year, we are sharing messages and graphics from our newly launched Public Health Heroes League campaign. This innovative campaign features a diverse cast of fictional graphic novel characters, rendered in saturated, vibrant color, to convey the story of how our health department works with the community to tackle real public health challenges and prevent illnesses, injuries and deaths. While the campaign features CCDPH, it could represent any local health department because all health departments have similar core functions.

This social media toolkit includes graphics and messages from the campaign, featuring public health heroes fighting the opioid epidemic and tuberculosis, guarding against lead hazards, promoting immunizations, conducting community outreach and providing resources to schools. It was developed to show excellence through diversity – the diversity of our staff and the diversity of the residents we serve.
