Threat Assessment

- A threat is a concerning communication or behavior that indicates that an individual poses a danger to the safety of school staff or students through acts of violence or other behavior that would cause harm to self or others.
- A threat assessment is a process of evaluating the risk for violence posed by someone who has expressed intent to inflict harm on others and the development of a safety plan.
- This process is completed by a team: principal, mental health provider,
 School Resource Officer (SRO)
