EPA's Incident Waste Decision Support Tool (I-WASTE) is a web-based decision support tool that organizes information related to managing waste resulting from natural disasters, terrorist attacks, or animal health emergencies. I-WASTE can be used by emergency response authorities, waste industry stakeholders, as well as state, tribal and local agencies responsible for making waste management decisions. The tool provides access to guidance to work through important waste management issues to ensure public and worker safety during the removal, transport, treatment and disposal of contaminated waste, as well as tools to estimate waste quantities and locate potential treatment and disposal facilities.



This training webinar will provide an overview of I-WASTE for new users as well as demonstrate functionality for veteran users. The first part of the webinar will provide a general overview of I-WASTE including what it is used for, why it was developed, and who can benefit from using it. The second portion of the webinar will be a step-by-step tutorial followed by a Q&A session.
