When To Use Discharge Conditions

- When is a conditional discharge order appropriate?
 - Patient is otherwise medically ready for discharge right now.
 - AND
 - When discharge is expected on the same day after condition is met.

Things That Are Not Supported Discharge Conditions

1. Meds to beds delivery
Why: Part of route DC
2. Radiology study
Why: DC priority specified in separate order
3. Procedure completed
Why: Potential for complications
4. Pain control adequate
Why: Provider must assess
5. Awaiting facility placement
Why: Unpredictable timeline

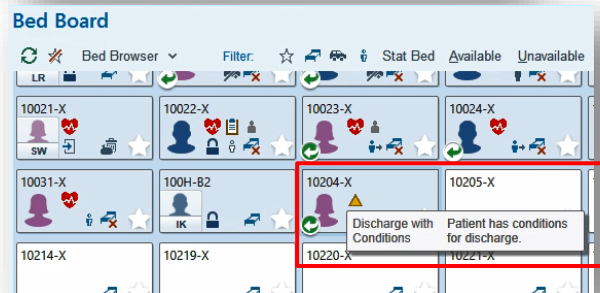
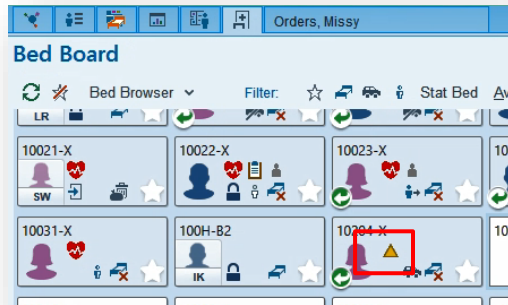
