

Conditional Discharge Order 2.0

- Planning for VUH-wide go-live on Wednesday, March 27th




When To Use Discharge Conditions

- When is a conditional discharge order appropriate?
 - Patient is otherwise medically ready for discharge right now.
 - AND
 - When discharge is expected on the same day after condition is met.



Things That Are Not Supported Discharge Conditions

- Meds to beds delivery
 Why: Part of route DC
- Radiology study
 Why: DC priority specified in separate order
- Procedure completed Why: Potential for complications
- 4. Pain control adequate Why: Provider must assess
- 5. Awaiting facility placement *Why: Unpredictable timeline*



Discharge Conditions –RN determines if condition met

- Tolerates diet
 - Optional: "Specify detail for tolerating diet"
- Post bowel movement
- Post void
- Lab is within normal range per doctor's specifications
 - Mandatory: "Specify lab"
- Specialty education completed
 - Optional: "Specify education discharge condition"
- Infusion complete
- Wound care complete
- Delivery of DME prior to discharge
- Confirmation of DME delivery plan
- Other

 communicate to team if there is a discrepancy with discharge disposition.






Downstream Visibility in Order


- RN workflow


Downstream Visibility in Order

- RN workflow
 - Manage orders (in title)
 - Orders review (in title)



Downstream Visibility in Order

- Bed Board
 - Orange triangle to indicate conditional discharge order
 - Specific conditions load to sidebar with single click
- Unit Manager
 - Orange background to differentiate conditional discharge order vs regular discharge



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
