## WELCOME

Welcome to Tots2Teens' October half term brochure. Tots2Teens offers a wide range of activities to keep young people entertained during the school holidays.

To be eligible to attend sessions, children must live or go to school in the Broadland District Council area.

Tots2Teens holiday activities club has now been running for 30 years. Join us for new sessions as well as some of our favourites. To mark the occasion, each child will receive a reusable water bottle upon attending a session.

We offer a 50% reduction on all activities for Broadland households claiming means tested benefits. These include Council Tax reduction, Housing Benefit, Universal Credit, Income-based Jobseeker's Allowance, Incomerelated Employment and Support Allowance, Income Support, Child Tax Credit, and Working Tax Credit. Please provide the booking team with your National Insurance number to claim a discount.

Payment must be made by credit or debit card at the time of booking.

We will provide healthy snacks for each child at our sessions this October half term, these have been kindly donated by The East of England Co-op. All participants must bring a packed lunch and refillable drink bottle to each session.

All fees are non-refundable, unless we are able to fill the space. In the event that we have to cancel a session, we will endeavour to give at least a week's notice and a refund will be provided.

If you wish for your child/ren to attend and leave an activity without an adult, we will require written permission from the parent/carer stating this intention before the date of the relevant activity.

Please note: Children may only be dropped off and registered from 10 minutes before the start of the session.

Tots2Teens holiday activities follow guidance for out-of-school childcare. All staff have an enhanced Disclosure & Barring Service check. If you would like to inspect our operational handbook, please ask a member of staff.
