STUDENTS NEEDING SPONSORSHIP A child's future is measured by

their ability to read and write. It is crucial to their cognitive

development and progression into gainful

employment. Without these skills more often than not these children are unable to reach their full God-given potential and more likely to remain in poverty. At this time we have 12 x Primary students from grade 2 to 9 @ \$105/year and 2 x Grade 10 High School students @ \$360/year that have started school and need sponsoring. INFORMATION FOR SPONSORS

Letter writing

Please be aware that postage to Zambia has been restored. Don't forget the impact you are making when you pour your heart and soul into a letter. Sometimes you may receive a disappointing response. It's natural to feel discouraged or wonder if your support is even making a difference. While the letters you receive back may not always be what you hope for never forget the impact your letters and support are having on both your sponsored child and their family and indeed the wider community. If you would like to write to your sponsored child please put your letter into an envelope and even add some stickers or postcard or photos. Keep it flat. Please do not use any of your details – just your name. Label the envelope with your child's name and Identity Number. Then put that envelope into another one no larger than a DL (business size) envelope keeping the envelope looking as boring as possible and do not include your return address and post to:

GCE (General Certificate in Education)

When a student reaches year 9 they must sit an external exam. Their exam registration then ceases. Generally those students that fail must leave school. However the Zambian Government has created the GCE which is a class that can be attended (out of normal school hours) and the students have an opportunity to study specifically that subject that they failed and are then able to re sit that subject exam. This year we have instigated, in our Education Program, facilities for our sponsors, if they wish, to financially support their student in this endeavour. I am really thrilled to report that all our sponsors of students who applied for GCE have engaged in this program. Thank you so much for giving your student a second chance.
