Ms. Didehban is Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) of Mayo Clinic in Arizona, the No. 1 hospital in the state as ranked by U.S. News & World Report. Ms. Didehban works with Richard Gray, M.D., CEO, to provide leadership and strategy, define and implement Mayo Clinic's operational plan, and expand Mayo's leadership in Arizona and the Southwest.

Prior to becoming CAO of Mayo Clinic in Arizona in 2022, Ms. Didehban worked as Mayo Clinic's chair of Practice Administration, providing strategic and operational direction for clinical functions including quality, patient experience, nursing, clinical systems and other Practice shared services. She also served as secretary of the Mayo Clinic Clinical Practice Committee.

Since joining Mayo Clinic in 2002, Ms. Didehban has served in the roles of administrative fellow, operations administrator and associate administrator. Throughout her career at Mayo Clinic, she has been a member of numerous committees at the site and enterprise levels, including serving as administrative leader for the Arizona Clinical Practice Committee, Outpatient Practice Subcommittee, and Operations Coordinating Group.

Ms. Didehban holds the rank of assistant professor, Health Care Administration, and is a fellow of the American College of Healthcare Executives. Ms. Didehban earned a Bachelor of Science in Community Health from the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign and a Master of Health Science in Health Finance and Management from Johns Hopkins University.
