Internal transfer process

- Meet all pre-requisite requirements with a minimum grade of B-;
- Internal transfer applicants must submit a letter of request, addressed to psu-aprnursing@plymouth.edu addressed to the chair of the Admission, Retention, Progression (APR) committee, by May 1st of the year requesting transfer admission.
 - Students cannot graduate from "Pre-Nursing." Students who do not meet the requirements for internal transfer at the end of their first year will be moved to the Allied Health Sciences: Pre-Professional Option.
