STATES THAT HAVE CERTIFIED THAT THEY REGULATE POLE ATTACHMENTS

WC Docket No. 10-101

The State of Florida certifies that it has issued and made effective rules and regulations implementing its regulatory authority over pole attachments in the state, including a specific methodology for such regulation that has been made publicly available in the state. Pursuant to section 1.1405(c) of the Commission's rules, the Commission hereby gives public notice of the receipt of Florida's certification. Certification by a state preempts the Commission from accepting pole attachment complaints under Subpart J of Part 1 of the Commission's rules.

Also pursuant to section 1.1405(c), the Commission compiles and publishes from time to time a listing of states that have provided certification.⁴ The following states have certified that they regulate the rates, terms, and conditions for pole attachments in their state, and, in so regulating, have the authority to consider and do consider the interests of consumers of the services offered via the attachments, as well as the interests of the consumers of the utility services. Moreover, these states have certified that they have issued and made effective rules and regulations implementing their regulatory authority over pole attachments, including a specific methodology for such regulation which has been made publicly available in the state.
