1. Changes since our last report

Since our last report at annual, we have welcomed one new member, Gina Solares of the Gleeson Library at the Geschke Center, University of San Francisco.

2. Statistics

Since our last report – November 24, 2021 – we have published 35 new citation forms. New and updated citations continue to be announced monthly on DCRM-L.

Between November 2021 and April 2022, the SCF site has averaged 1,414 sessions, 914 users, 730 new users, and 2,959 page views each month, a slight increase over last year.

3. Linked Data

The SCF continues to add URIs to citation forms where available. After reviewing Yale's report on converting standard citations into Wikidata, we decided that it would be worth adding these to our existing citations. We are now waiting on the Web Team to add a field in the database.
