The Three I's

The Hope Avenue consists of three main components:

- **1. Intentional Preparation**
- 2. Inclusive Gathering
- **3. Inspirational Sunday Service**



1. 05 Intentional Preparation /in'ten(t)SH(ə)n(ə)l/ / prepə'rāSH(ə)n/

noun

1. Worship and integration that are communicating, coordinating, holding planning meetings, and working well together.

examples:

- Planning meetings
- Team calendar



2. Inclusive Gathering /inˈkloosiv/ /ˈɡaTH(ə)riNG/

noun

1. Spaces for fellowship and developing new relationship.

examples:

 Intentionally welcoming, wellcoordinated ministries with clear next steps to discipleship: greeters, ushers, children's ministry, new member classes.



3. Inspirational Sunday Service /ˌinspə'rāSH(ə)n(ə)l/ /ˈsəndē/ /ˈsərvəs/

noun

1. Our service celebrates the nature and presence of our triune God and is interactive with congregational response.

examples:

 Communion, baptism, praise, confession, dedication, responsive reading, giving, scripture reading.
