#### **Texas Civil Commitment Program Overview**

The Texas Civil Commitment Office (TCCO) is responsible for providing appropriate and necessary treatment and supervision for civilly committed sexually violent predators. The philosophy of treatment is that services will address multiple areas of an individual's functioning in order to achieve a balanced lifestyle that is incompatible with sexual offending.

The treatment is delivered in five tiers. TCCO offers a comprehensive sex offender treatment program for all tiers. Tiers One through Four are located at the Texas Civil Commitment Center (TCCC). Tier Five is delivered while the client is residing in a home plan in the community. Clients at the TCCC participate in six hours of sex offender treatment weekly as well as additional programming. Client in Tier Five participate in sex offender treatment groups weekly and attend individual sessions monthly.

#### **Treatment Tiers:**

**Tier One – Responsibility**: This Tier will assist the client in building problem solving skills and focuses on how good decisions are made. Clients will learn to take accountability, develop an understanding of healthy vs deviant sexuality, work on understanding thinking errors and demonstrate a readiness to change.

**Tier Two - Awareness and Discovery**: The client will work on disclosure of offending behavior and their offense cycle, sexual history and relationships. This Tier will help the client work on their risk factors and develop a path towards establishing a balanced, self-determined lifestyle that is incompatible with offending behavior. Tier Two consists of two parts: Tier 2-Initial Placement or Incident Report (Tier 2-I) and Tier 2. Clients are placed in Tier 2-I for the first six (6) months of this tier. A client may also be considered for Tier 2-I if the client receives a sustained incident report.

**Tier Three - Healthy Relationships and Empathy:** This Tier will assist the client with controlling his risk factors, help build relationship skills and work on understanding others in a more empathic and emotionally healthy manner. The client will continue to develop skills and practice self-control behaviors, thoughts and emotions. Clients will work on a maintenance plan for managing their risk.

**Tier Four - Preparation for Community Reintegration**: The client has the opportunity to receive support and guidance while reinforcing the new skills they have learned in treatment. This tier also prepares the client to return the community.

#### **Additional Programming at the TCCC:**

- Life Skills
- Individual Sessions are provided every 90 days and when needed or upon request
- Weekly Study Hall/Required for Tier 1 and 2 and sometimes in higher tiers if needed
- Weekly Community Meetings
- Spiritual Services

- Alcohol and Substance Abuse Treatment Services
- NA/AA
- Education Classes
- Resume Writing
- Budgeting
- Structured and open recreation
- Therapeutic Work Program offers employment and vocational training opportunities to clients while residing in the TCCC. The Therapeutic Work Program will help clients to develop skills and personal habits necessary for gainful employment upon release to the community. Clients are eligible for employment based on their tier level. Clients placed in the work program are paid minimum wage.
- Clients are assigned to a Case Manager who will assist clients in multiple areas.

- Progression through the tiers is self-paced. As a client progresses through the tiers, the client is able to earn more privileges and may be moved to less restrictive housing within the TCCC.
- Visitation is allowed by family and friends who are approved contacts. Visitation may be in-person or by video. Visitation is from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturdays and Sundays, as well as on designated holidays. Exceptions for in-person visitation may be made in advance for visitors traveling a certain distance.

**Tier Five** – **Community Treatment:** The client will continue to receive treatment and supervision that will reinforce the skills learned in treatment. The goals for Tier Five are for the client to continue to build healthy relationships and social support systems, identify high-risk situations, and to be a productive citizen who is free from offending behavior with the ultimate goal of no more victims.

Privileges and Property for clients at the Texas Civil Commitment Center in Tier 1-4 are listed on the next page. Privileges and property for Tier 5 clients are determined on a case-by-case basis.
