When: February 12<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup>

Where: Trivium Prep Stage

**What**: Come with your audition packet filled out and your audition song ready to be performed on February 12<sup>th</sup>. (School uniform is *acceptable* February 12<sup>th</sup> but

blacks are *preferred*.)

You will need to dress in black workout clothes for your dance audition on February 13<sup>th</sup>. Your black clothing must follow the school dress codes guidelines.

Make sure leggings are not see-through and shirts reflect modesty.

February 15<sup>th</sup> will be used as a callback day. This will **not** be a **mandatory** audition for all auditioners, but you **must** be available if you are called back.

**Time**: 3:30 pm-5:30 pm

Be sure when you show up for your audition that ALL of your paperwork is completed before you begin your audition on February 12<sup>th</sup> to Mrs. MacLeod by 3:30pm. You will not be able to audition if the following check sheet is not completed fully. Do not turn this packet in before the beginning of auditions.


# Calendar Agreement
