Best Practices for Cataloging Objects using RDA and MARC21

The Program Planning Group coordinated with Robert Freeborn, Jessica Janecki, and Julie Renee Moore of OLAC's cataloging objects guidelines to present "Best Practices for Cataloging Objects using RDA and MARC21". The webinar was three-hours in length and held on February 24, 2022. Liz Adams moderated. There were over 683 registrants and 300+ attendees. The recording was made available to participants for a limited time period.

Controlled vocabularies and you: a panel discussion on addressing and redressing terminologies through new and existing vocabularies

The Program Planning Group coordinated with representatives from four controlled vocabulary groups (Michelle Cronquist and Staci Ross from the African American SACO Funnel; Lillian Castillo-Speed from the Chicano Thesaurus; Ryan Hildebrand from RBMS Controlled Vocabularies Prejudicial Materials Working Group; and Shavonn Matsuda from Lau Ā Lau Ka 'Ike) to present an hour-long panel discussion on reparative description and controlled vocabularies. RBMS 2023

When BSC voted on topics in September 2021, one proposal from Gioia Stevens regarding visualizing a menu collection held at NYU received BSC support. The Program Planning Group did not feel there was time to solicit other projects for this session in time for RBMS 2022. The Group will work to solicit other projects in time for RBMS 2023.

In 2019, BSC voted to support a cataloging artist's books workshop to be held at RBMS 2020. The workshop did not happen at RBMS 2021 and will not be part of RBMS 2022. The Program Planning Group will work with the presenters to see if RBMS 2023 is the right venue for the workshop.
