FISCAL MEMORANDUM

HB 1634 - SB 2766

February 12, 2024

SUMMARY OF BILL AS AMENDED (013578): Revises language preventing discriminating against students on certain, specified bases to prohibiting educators from discriminating against students on any basis.

FISCAL IMPACT OF BILL AS AMENDED:

NOT SIGNIFICANT

Assumptions for the bill as amended:

- Tennessee Code Annotated § 49-5-1003 establishes an educator's obligation to students and requires an educator to follow all applicable federal and state laws and to not generally exclude, discriminate against, or unfairly treat students.
- The proposed legislation does not significantly affect an educator's obligation to students, and it is assumed that educators will not alter their curriculum, teaching methodology, or treatment of students as a result of this legislation.
- Schools and educators will be able to comply with the proposed legislation within existing resources such that any fiscal impact is estimated to be not significant.
