

Casey Life Skills Data Download Guide

Have you taken or administered a Casey Life Skills (CLS) assessment in the past? Here's how to download your data from the CLS system:

- 1. Log in to <u>http://lifeskills.casey.org</u>.
- 2. Go to Reports.
- 3. Click Export All Assessment Responses.

- 4. A compressed folder called **assessments.zip** will be downloaded to your default downloads folder.
- 5. Find the downloaded file and decompress it.
 - a. In Windows, right click the file, then select Extract All...
 - b. In MacOS, double-click the file
- The resulting assessments folder will contain a separate CSV file for each assessment type, including supplements. The main CLS assessment is titled Casey Life Skills Assessment.csv.

- 7. These files can be viewed in MS Excel or other spreadsheet applications, or they can be imported into your own youth assessment databases.
- 8. Each assessment in the CSV file is represented as one row. Column headers include:
 - a. Name, ID and birthdate of the youth who completed the assessment.
 - b. Optional demographic data.
 - c. Youth answers to assessment questions (one question per column).
