Undocumented students, including DACA

 -Dates of birth -Marriage, divorce, separation date(s)	✓	✓
 2020 Federal tax returns, W2s (or 1099) and Schedules	✓	✓
 Records of untaxed income (child support statements, TANF, Free & reduced Lunch, Medicaid, SSI, SNAP, WIC, VA benefits)	✓	✓
 Cash, savings and checking account balances	✓	✓
 Investments other than the home in which you live (farm, business, stocks, bonds, 529)	✓	✓
