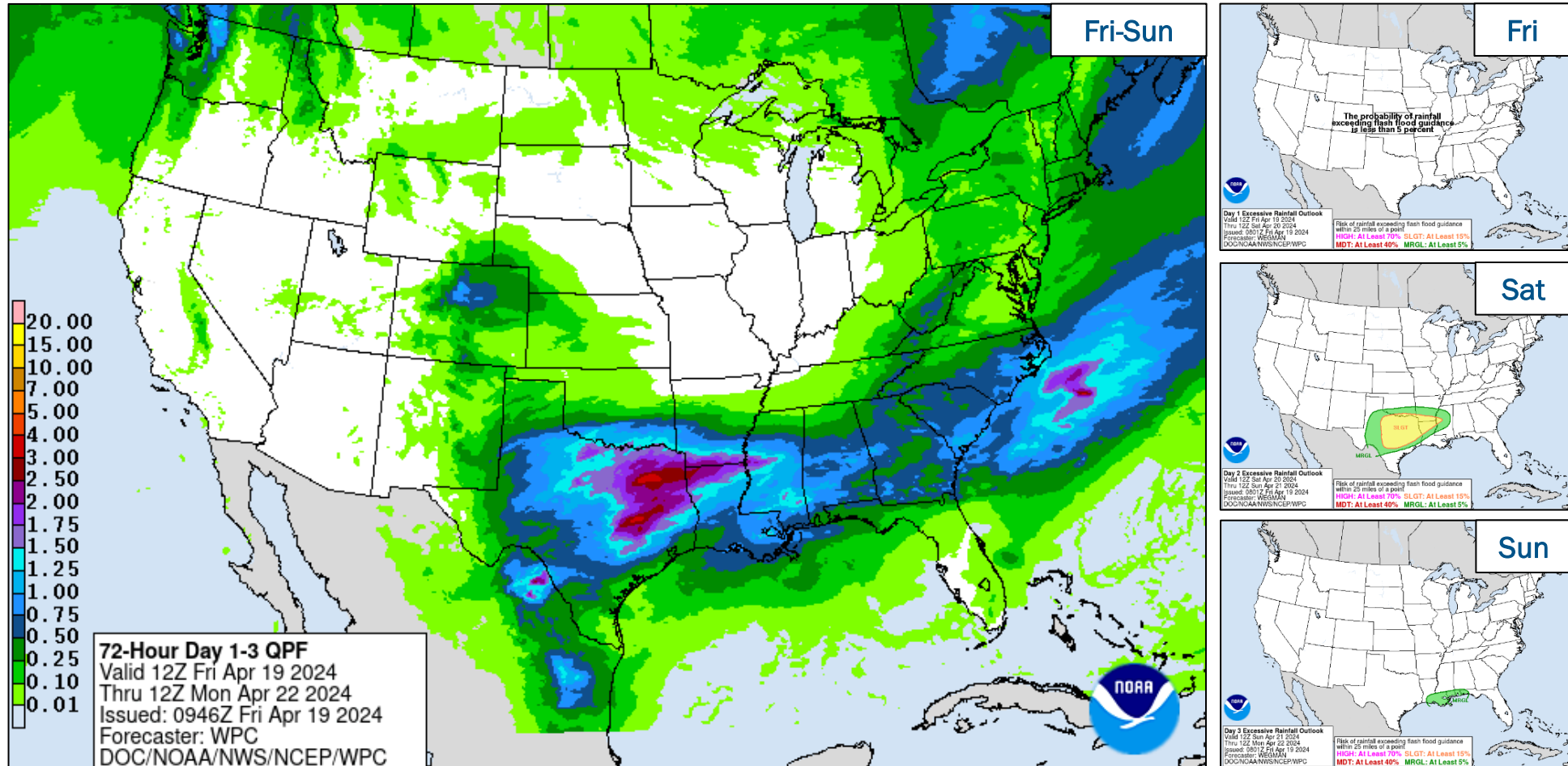
National Weather Forecast

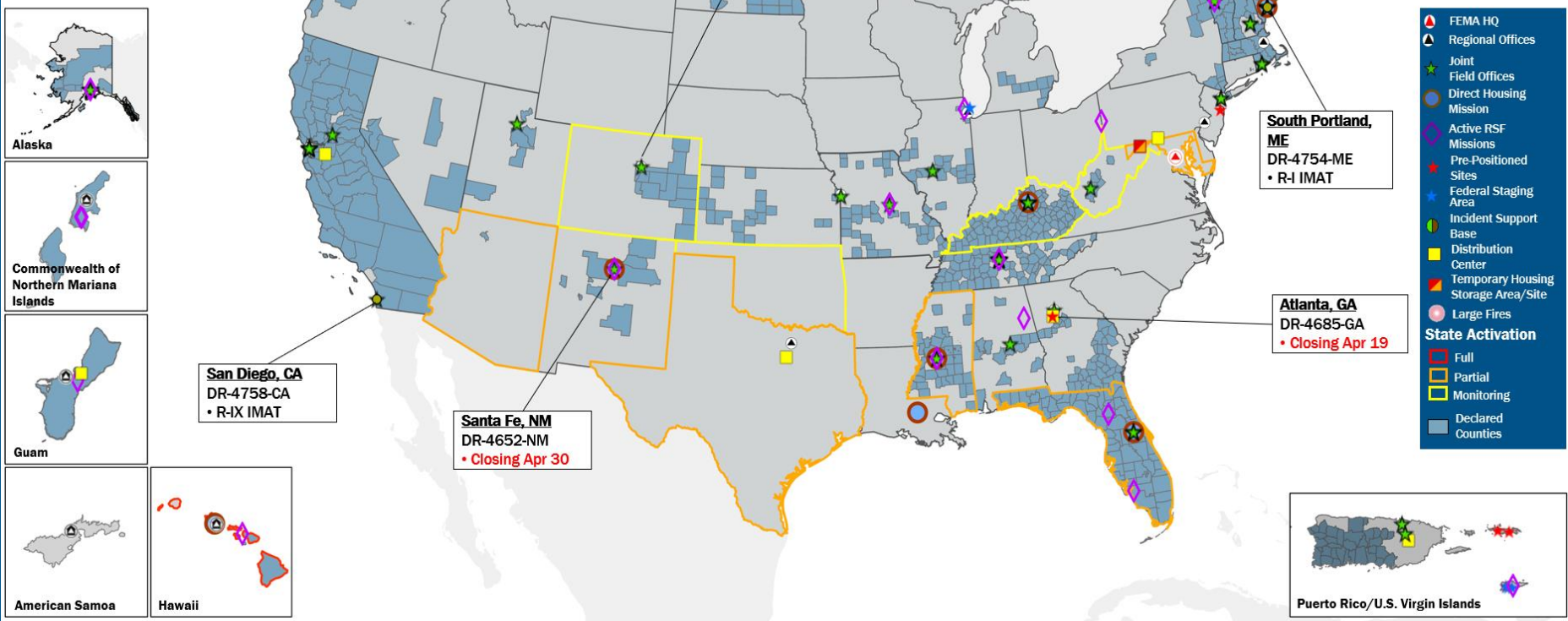
