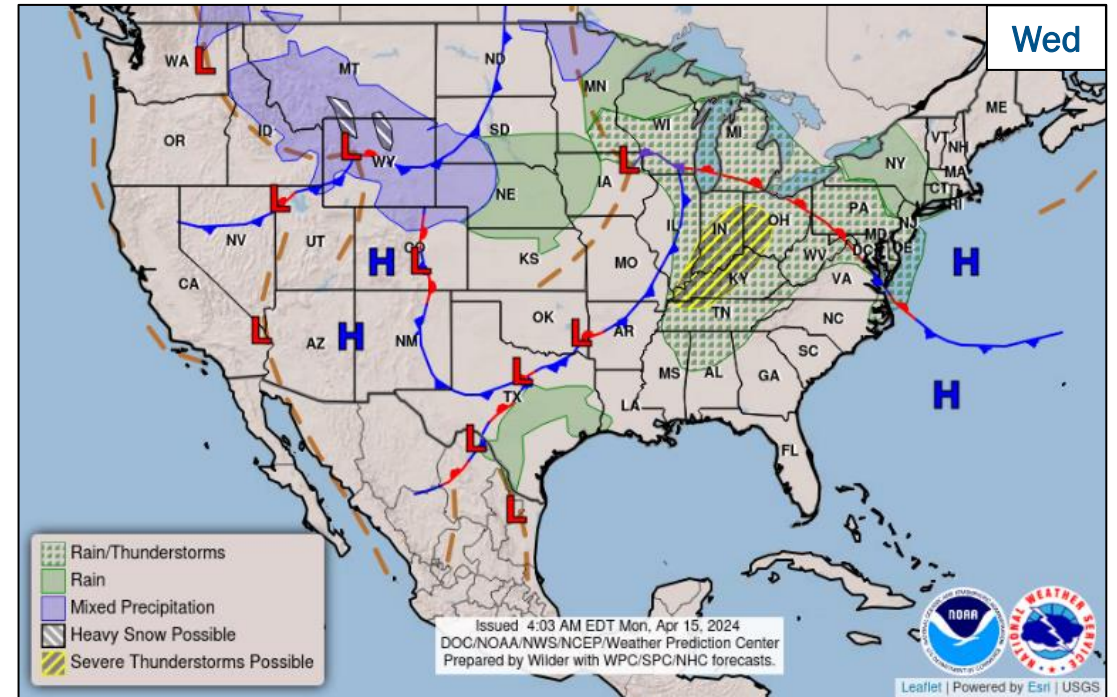
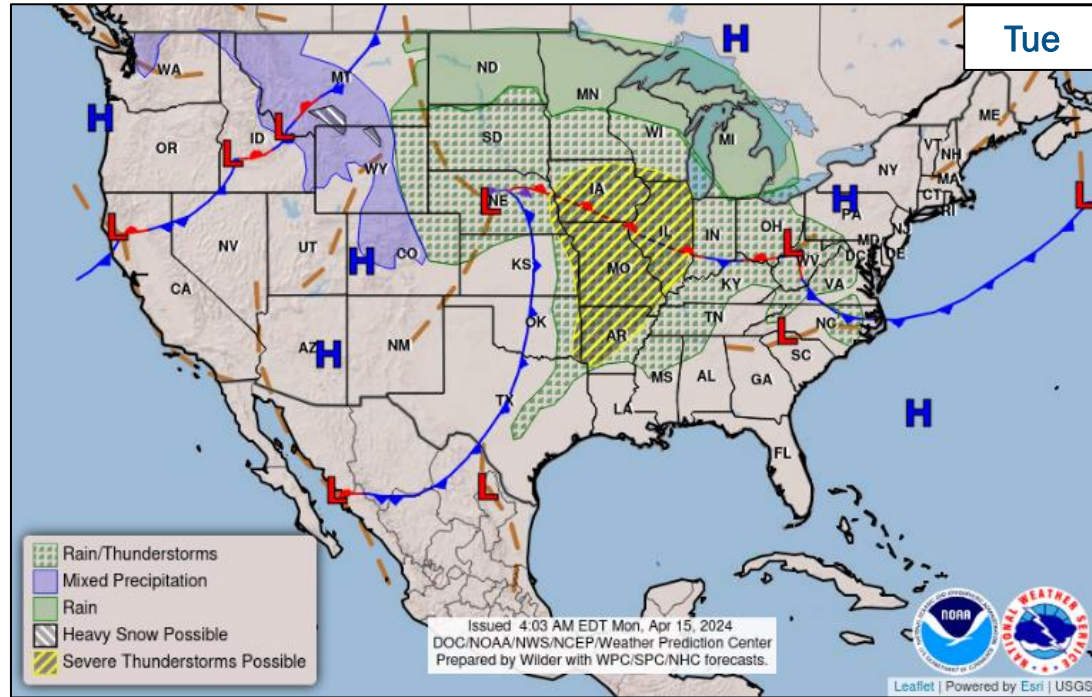

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National Weather Forecast



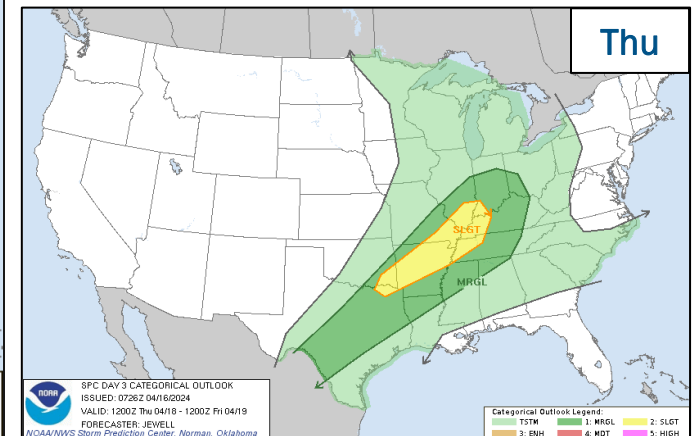
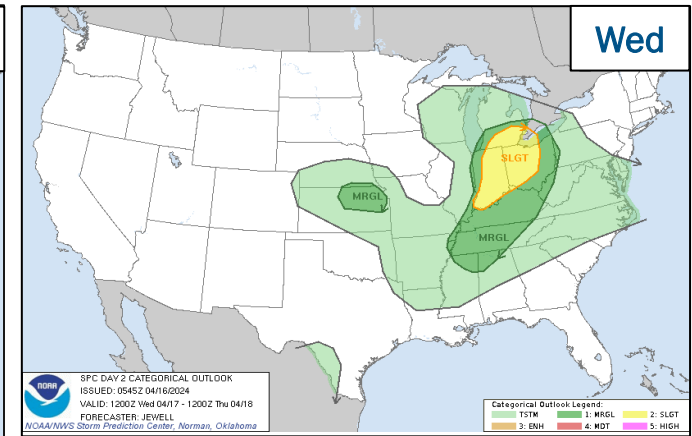
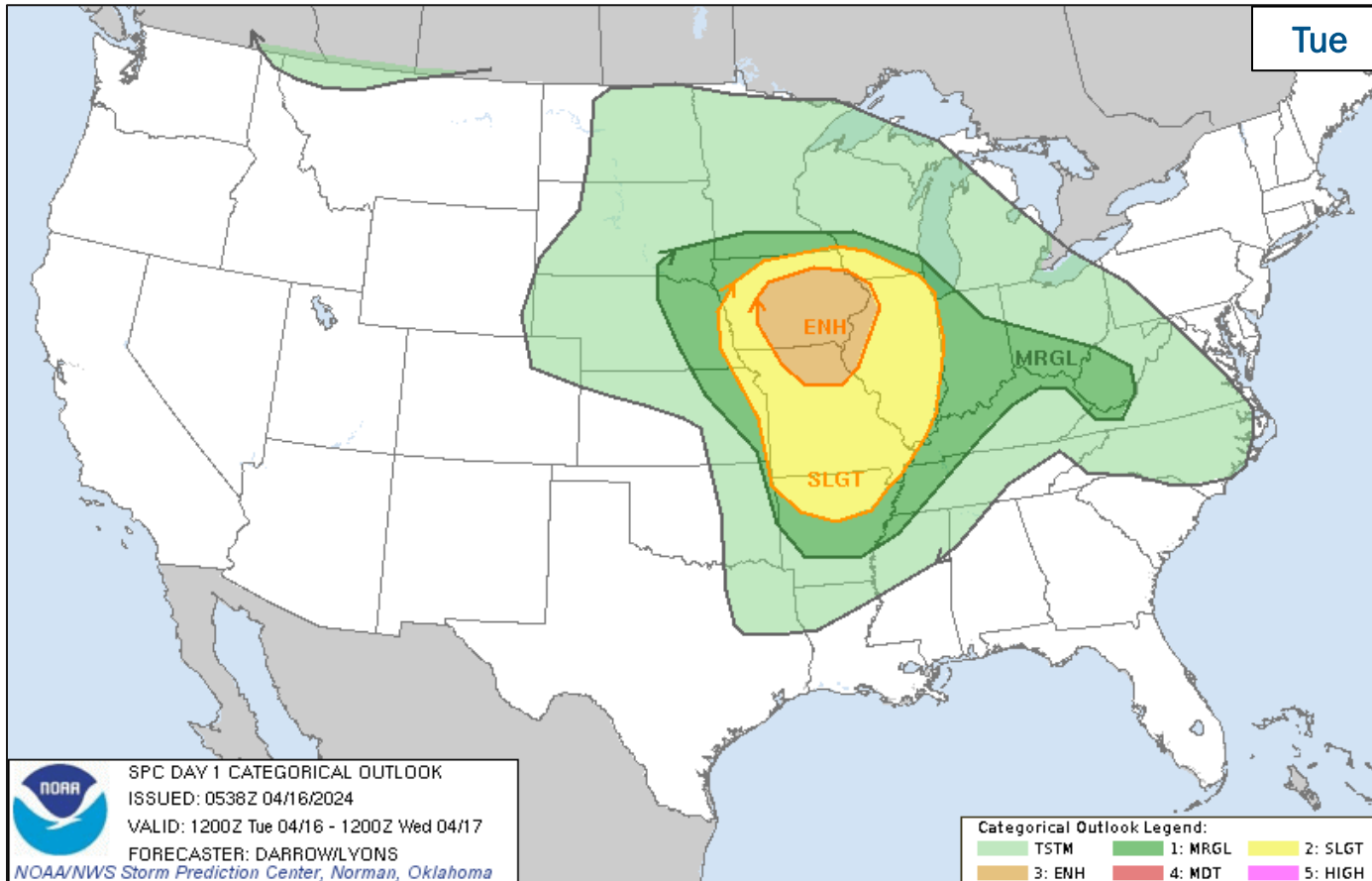

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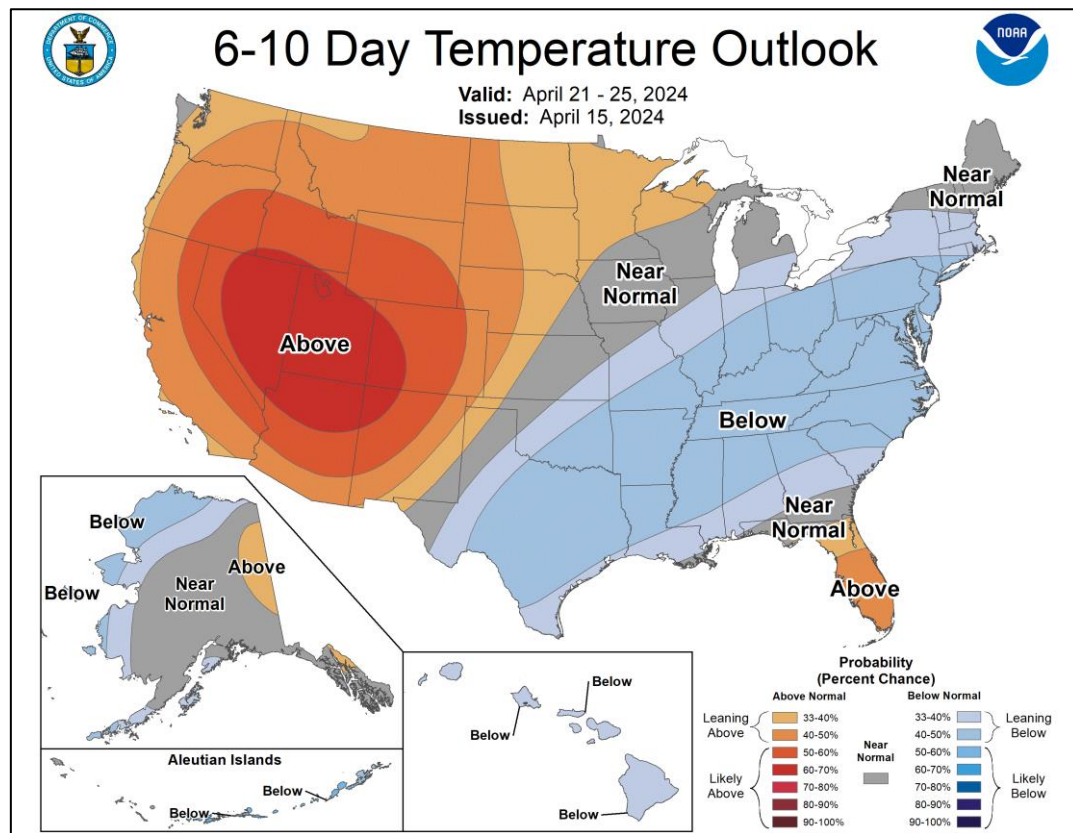
Severe Weather Outlook



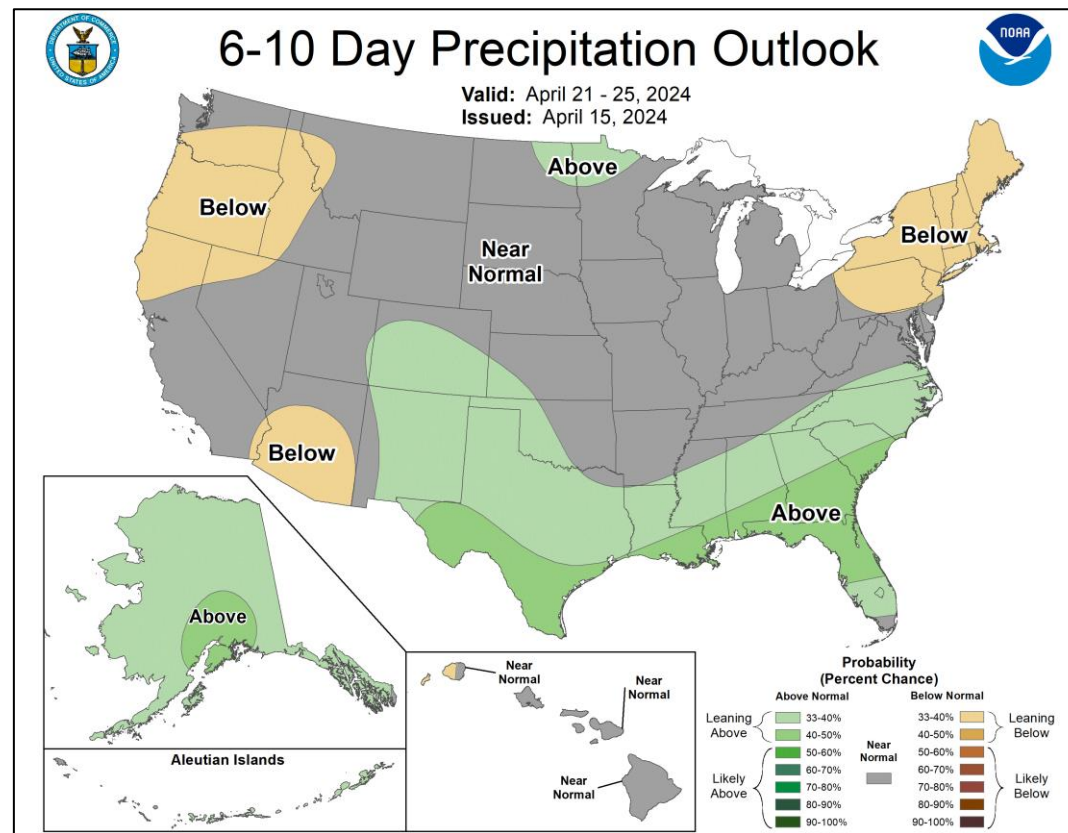
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Long Range Outlooks – Apr 21-25

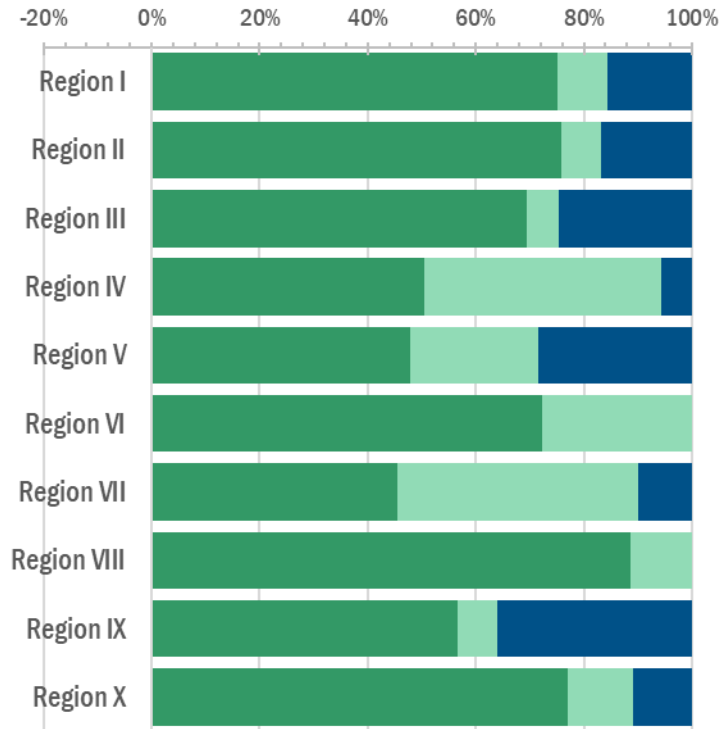

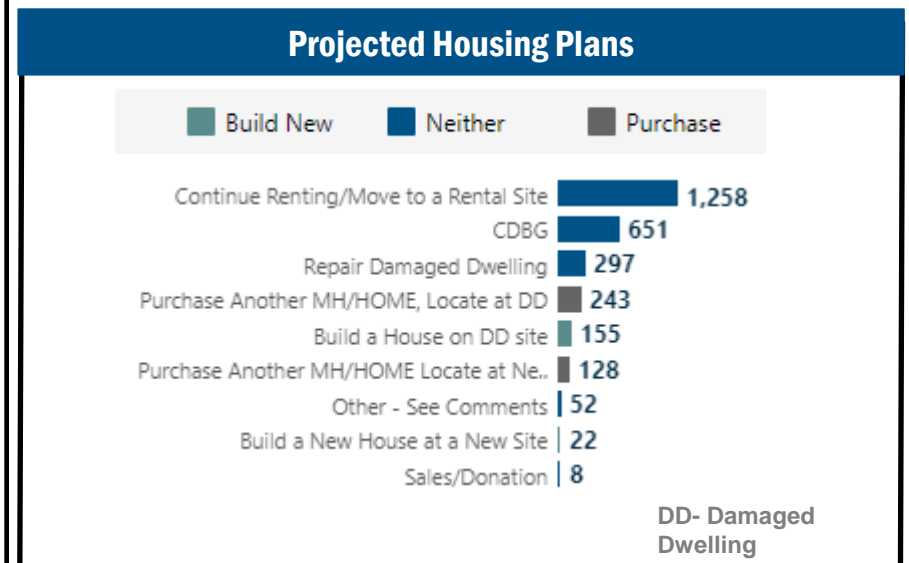
