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Severe Weather – FEMA Regions VI & VII

Situation: Over the weekend 127 tornado touchdowns, 149 wind reports, and 173 hail reports were reported in Regions VI and VII. [Severe weather and excessive rainfall concerns remain for parts of the Upper/Middle Mississippi Valley and Great Plains through this week.](#)

Food, Hydration, Shelter:

FEMA Region VI:

- TX: 2 ARC shelter open / 16 occupants
- OK: 68 homes destroyed / 59 damaged; State assessments ongoing (*Geospatial Damage Assessment, as of 5:14 p.m. ET, Apr 28*)
 - 2 ARC shelters open / 17 occupants

FEMA Region VII:

- NE: 99 homes destroyed / 50 damaged; State assessments ongoing (*Geospatial Damage Assessment, as of 5:14 p.m. ET, Apr 28*)
- IA: 49 (+17) homes destroyed / 71 damaged; State assessments ongoing (*RVII Update as of 3:05 a.m. ET, Apr 30*)
- KS: 6 homes damaged (*RVII IR #3 as of 2:05 p.m. ET, Apr 28*)

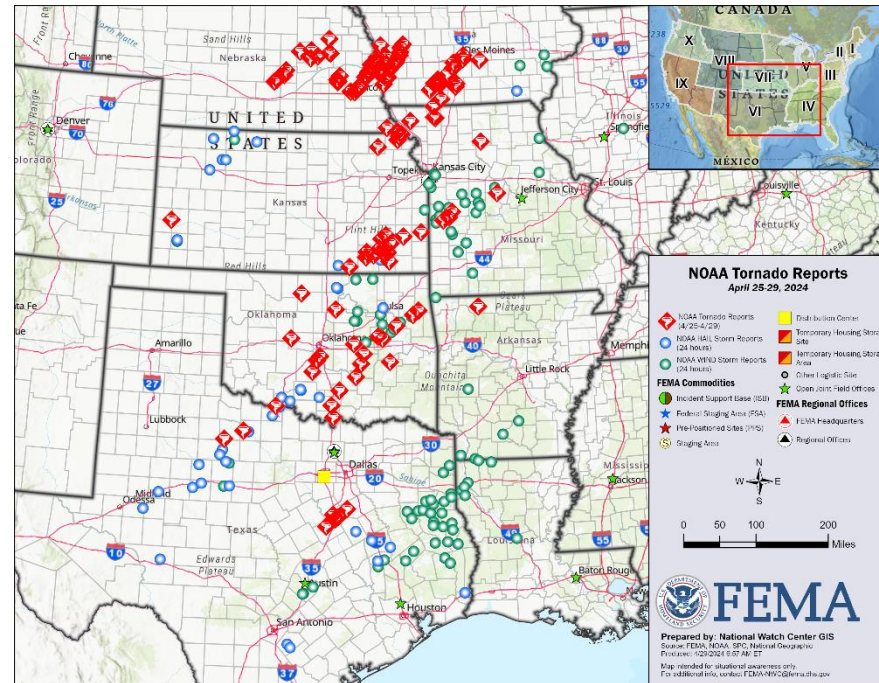
Health and Medical:

FEMA Region VI:

- TX: 0 fatalities / 2 injuries reported
- OK: 4 (+2) confirmed fatalities / 100 injuries reported

FEMA Region VII:

- NE: 0 fatalities reported / 3 injuries reported statewide
- IA: 1 fatality confirmed / 7 injuries reported statewide



State / Local Response:

FEMA Region VI:

- TX EOC is at Partial Activation
- OK EOC is at **Monitoring**
 - Governor declared a State of Emergency

FEMA Region VII:

- KS EOC is at **Normal Operations**
 - Governor issued a State of Disaster Emergency
- MO EOC at **Partial Activation**
- IA EOC at Normal Operations
 - Governor approved a Proclamation of Disaster Emergency for **9 counties** (*RVII Update as of 3:05 a.m. ET, Apr 30*)
- NE EOC at **Partial Activation**
- Ponca Tribe of Nebraska Declared a State of Emergency

FEMA Response:

Region VI: at Normal Operations; RRCC is Rostered

- R-IMAT 1 deployed to OK EOC; R-IMAT 2 is available
- TX FIT is available; OK FIT in OK EOC

Region VII: at Normal Operations; RRCC is Rostered

- R-IMAT and LNOs are on alert; IA & NE FIT available

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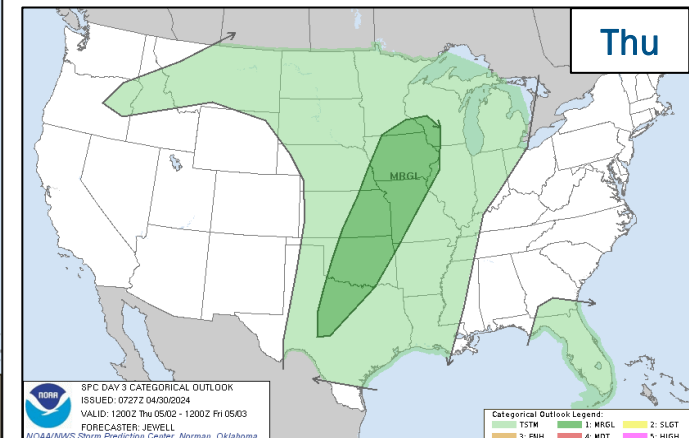
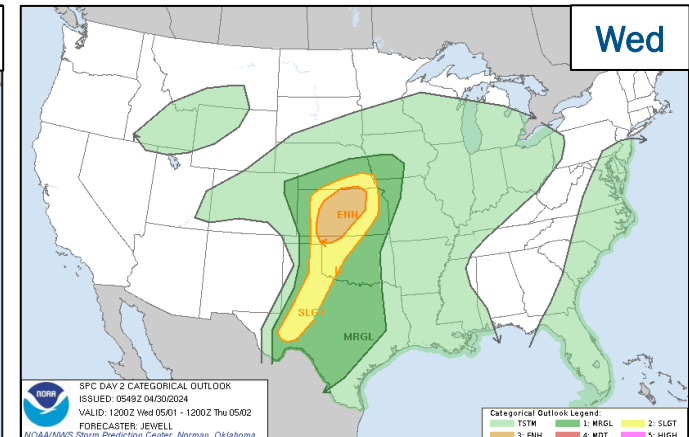
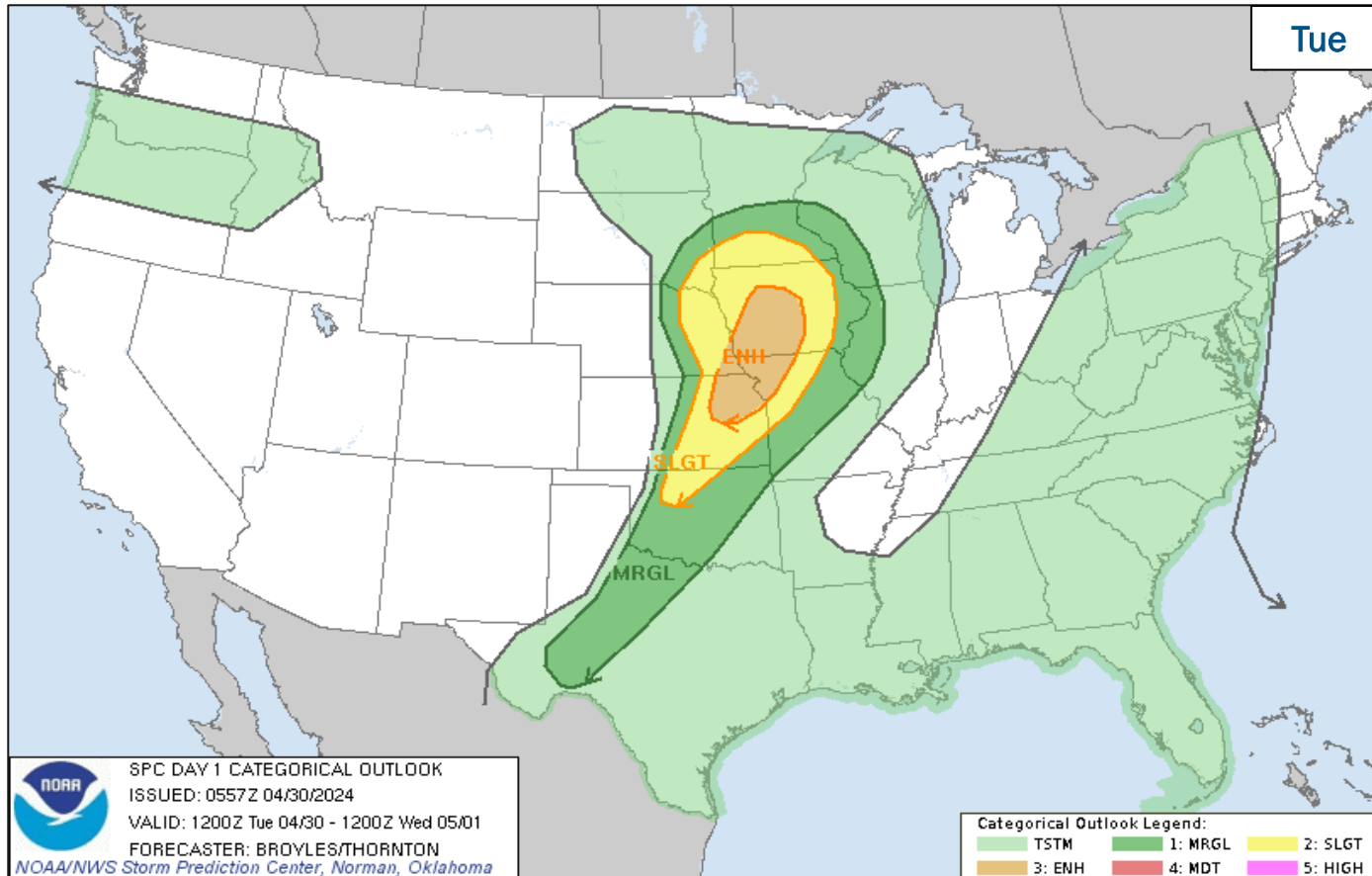
National Weather Forecast



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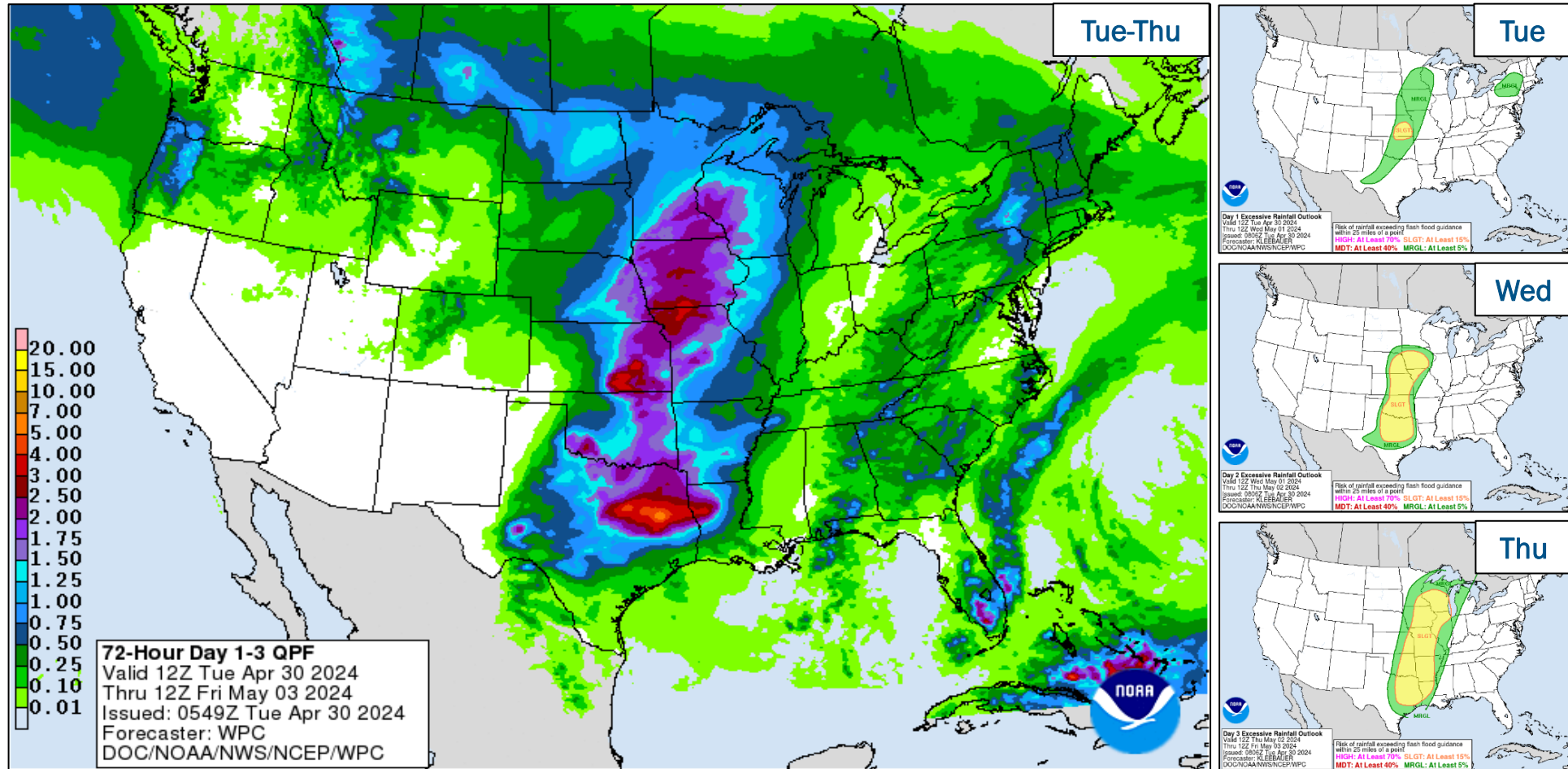
Severe Weather Outlook



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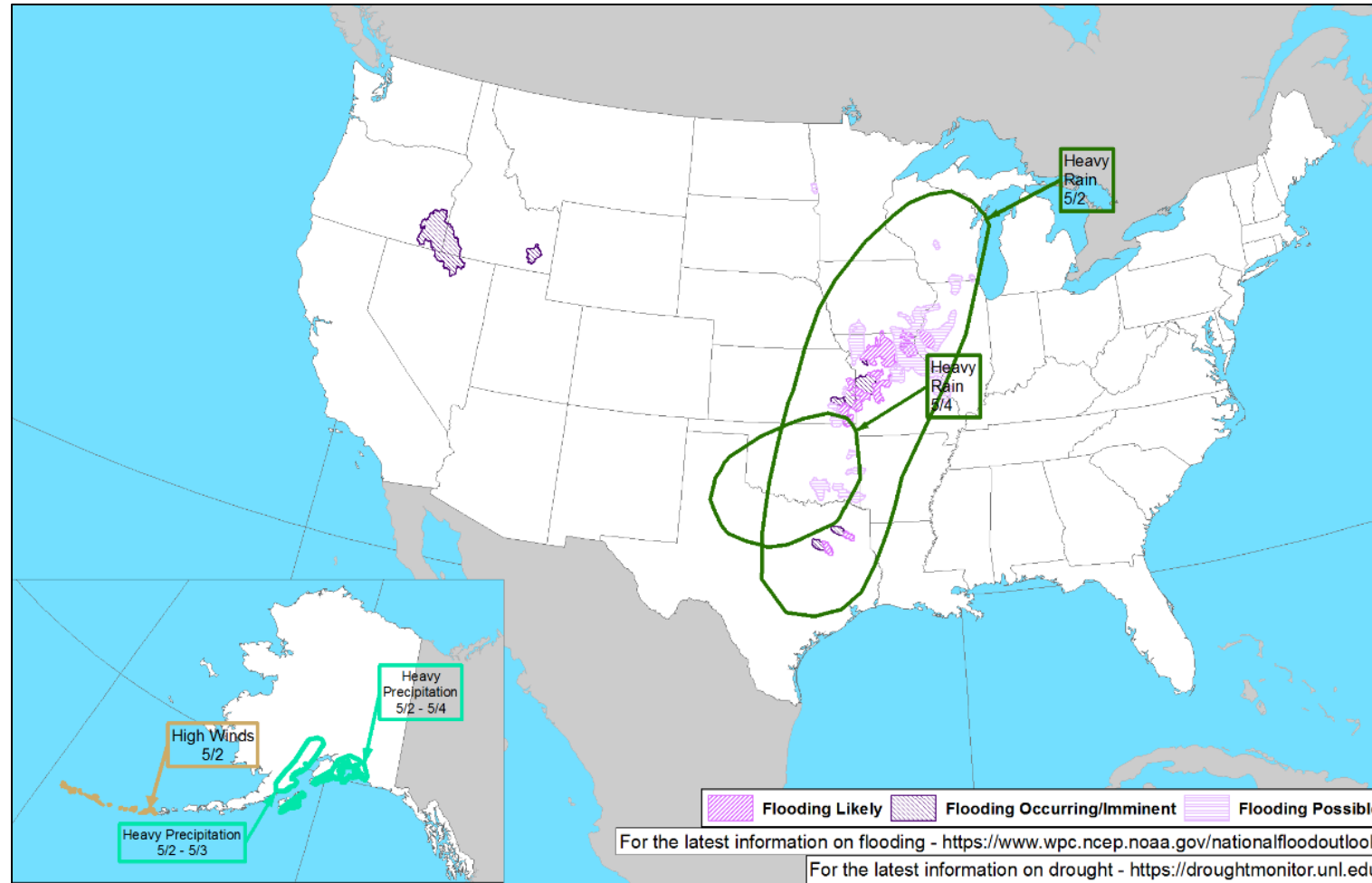
Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall

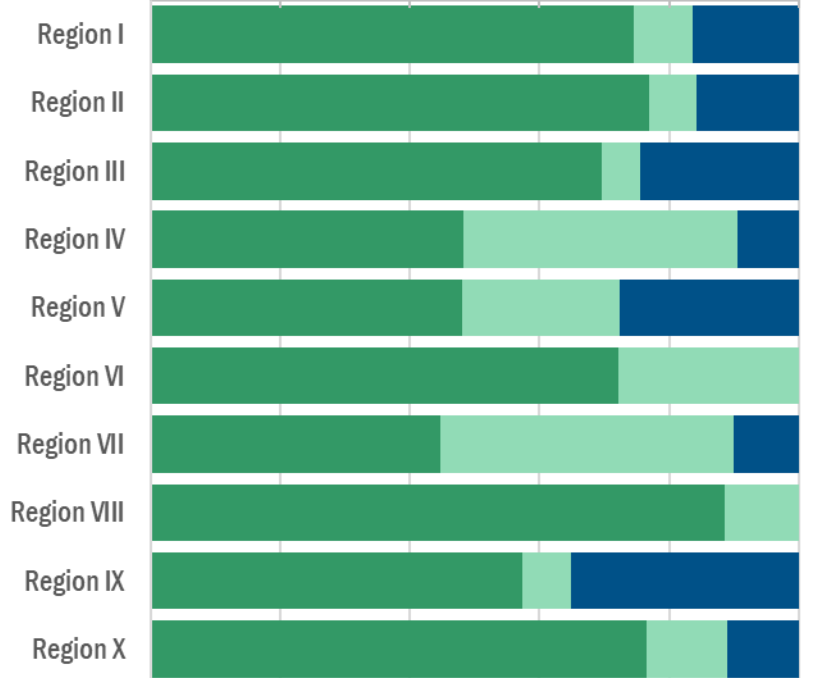

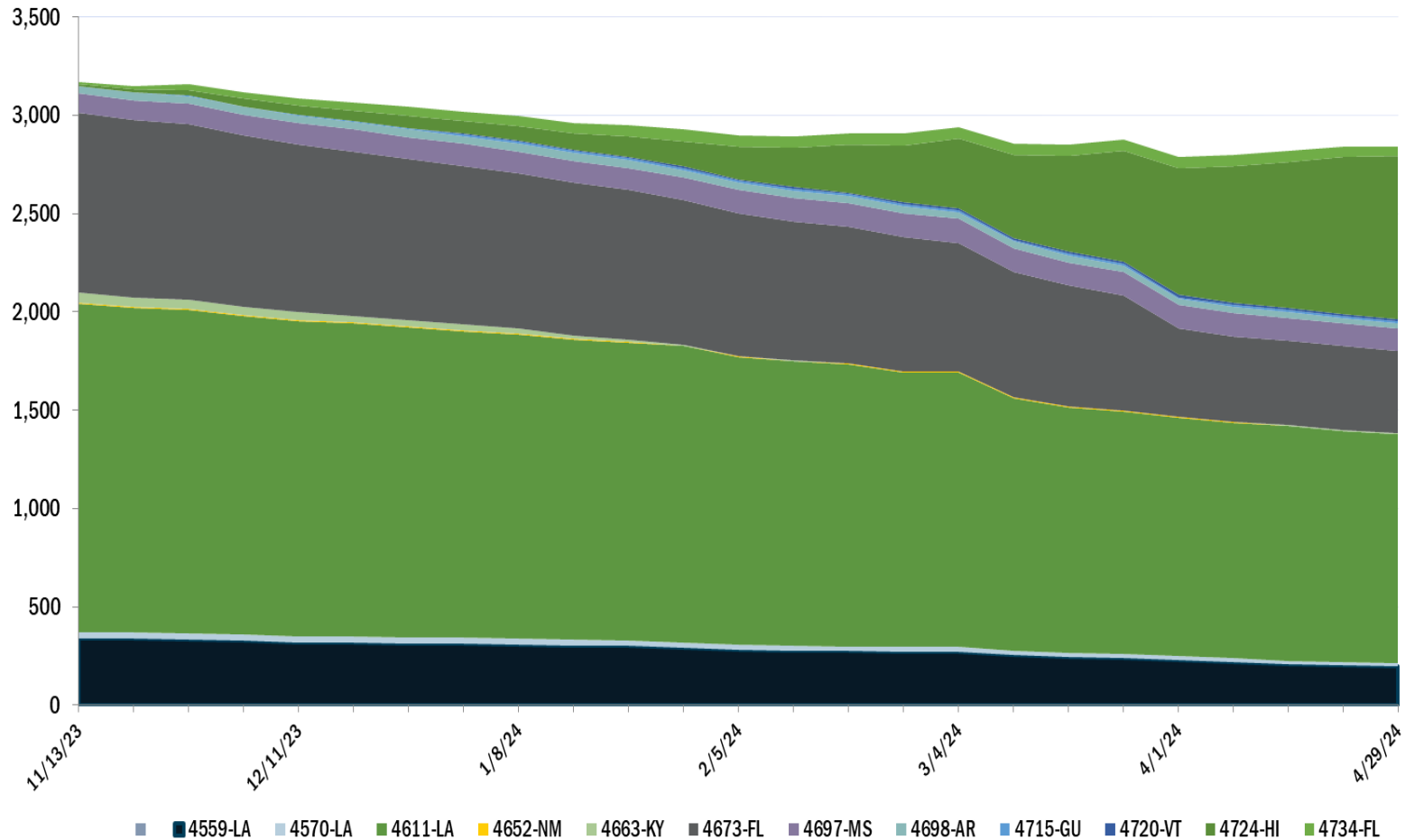

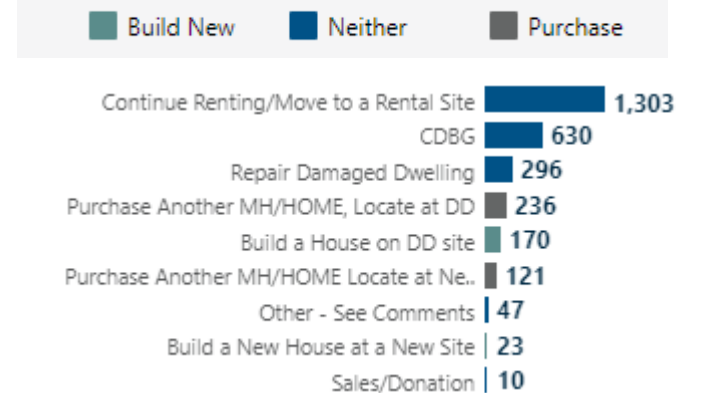
