Severe Weather – FEMA Regions VI & VII

<u>Situation:</u> Over the weekend 127 tornado touchdowns, 149 wind reports, and 173 hail reports were reported in Regions VI and VII. Severe weather and excessive rainfall concerns remain for parts of the Upper/Middle Mississippi Valley and Great Plains through this week.








National Weather Forecast






Severe Weather Outlook






Precipitation & Excessive Rainfall
