1 AN ACT concerning the names required on applications for professional and occupational licensure and supplementing 2 3 P.L.1978, c.73 (C.45:1-21 et seq.). 4 5 **BE IT ENACTED** by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 6 of New Jersey: 7 8 1. a. An application to be completed for a professional or 9 occupational license, certificate of registration, or certification, or 10 for a renewal, reactivation or reinstatement of a professional or 11 occupational license, certificate of registration, or certification, 12 shall include: (1) a line for the applicant to list a professional name; 13 14 (2) a line for the individual to list a legal name, if different from 15 the professional name; and 16 (3) the ability for the applicant to choose which of the names is to appear on the license, certificate of registration or certification. 17 b. Notwithstanding any law, rule, or regulation to the contrary, 18 19 this section shall apply to every applicant for or holder of a 20 professional or occupational license, certificate of registration, or 21 certification issued, renewed, reactivated, or reinstated by a board 22 specified in section 2 of P.L.2013, c. 253 (C.45:1-15). 23 24 2. This act shall take effect on the first day of the sixth month 25 next following enactment, except that anticipatory administrative 26 action in advance may be taken as necessary for the implementation of this act. 27 28 29 **STATEMENT** 30 31 This bill clarifies current State policy requiring an individual to 32 list a legal name on an application when initially applying for or 33 renewing, reactivating, or reinstating a professional or occupational 34 license, certificate of registration, or certificate. 35 The bill requires applications for a professional and occupational 36 license, certificate of registration, or certificate to include a line 37 allowing an individual to list a professional name, a line for the 38 individual to list a legal name, if different from the professional 39 name, and the ability for the individual to choose which name is to 40 appear on the license, certificate of registration, or certificate. 41 This bill allows individuals who practice a specific profession or 42 occupation by one name to retain that name should the individual's 43 legal name change. Allowing an individual who has built a business 44 under one name to continue using it even if the surname of the 45 individual legally changes will prevent confusion among consumers 46 who are clients of that individual. It will also allow the individual to forgo any additional costs required to obtain an updated license, 47 48 certificate of registration, or certification, and to update any 49 business website, advertising, or marketing.
