Cornell faculty and Cornell Cooperative Extension educators jointly apply to CCE for a fully funded (\$6,000) Student intern. Interns work all summer on a project that involves research and outreach; topics can include sustainability, youth development, & nutrition.

CHE Engaged Course Grants: \$4,000

Engaged Course Grants support faculty in developing and teaching community-engaged learning courses in the College of Human Ecology. The goal is to support students learning with and from community partners.

CHE Engaged Research Seed Grants: \$4,000

Engaged Research Seed Grants support new research collaborations between faculty, undergraduates, and community partners that include Cooperative Extension.

CHE Engaged Opportunity Grants: \$2,000

Engaged Opportunity Grants are awarded to faculty and staff creating community-engaged learning opportunities for undergraduates. Funds support faculty projects seeking to provide timely responses to emerging community needs.
