


Navigate to portseattle.org/careers.

# Set Up New Applicant Account


- Click on the available high school internship job posting listed on the page. There will be two postings:
  - One for Skilled Trades titled, 'High School Intern Skilled Trades Summer 2024.'
  - One for all other roles titled, 'High School Intern Summer 2024.'
- You may apply to both.

After reading the job description, click the 'Apply Online' button to continue to the application process.

- Log in to your existing account OR follow the instructions to create a new account.
- Be sure to save your password for future access.




## Resume Upload

Upload a resume that contains, at minimum, the following:


- Your contact information (email and phone)
- 2. Education
- Any relevant employment, volunteering, or school projects - this may include informal experience, such as with family or community

## Personal Information

Select from the dropdown where you heard about the application.



- Community Partner Affiliation
  - If you are affiliated with a Community Partner, please select the appropriate organization you are associated with from the list provided.
  - 'Affiliated with' means having a formal or informal relationship with the organization. You may have participated in their programming, be an enrolled member, and/or receive services from this organization.

You will be asked to respond several to short-answer questions on your application.

#### Short answer tips:

- Make sure your answers are the correct length noted in the question.
- Address all parts of the question in your response.
- For questions that ask 'why,' **be thoughtful** about your reasons and **explain why**.
- Be specific and include **details or examples** in your response.
- Demonstrate your understanding of internship program's structure and goals, as outlined in the job posting.




## File Attachments
