Call for a Caucus of the Rappahannock Democratic Committee to Elect Delegates and Alternates to the Fifth District and State Conventions

The Rappahannock County Democratic Committee (RCDC) hereby calls an unassembled caucus on Monday, April 20, 2020, from 7:30 p.m. to 9 p.m. at the Rappahannock County Public Library, 4 Library Road, Washington VA 22747 for the purpose of electing delegates and alternates to the VA Fifth District Convention on Saturday, May 14, 2020 and Virginia Democratic State Convention on Saturday, June 20, 2020 in Richmond, Virginia. No individual shall be eligible for election by the participants of the caucus whose name has not been filed with and received by the Chair of the Rappahannock Democratic Committee or his designated representative by 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 13, 2020.

In order to certify the eligibility of a candidate for election, the Chair shall ascertain that each prospective candidate is a resident of and registered to vote in Rappahannock County, Virginia; is a Democrat; does not intend to support, endorse, or assist any candidate who is opposed to a Democratic nominee or endorsee in the November 2020 election; is not a member of any other political party; and has not participated and will not participate in the nomination process of any other political party for the November 2020 election. A voluntary non-refundable administrative fee payable to RCDC of \$25 is requested accompany all candidate filings. No waiver is necessary if a candidate is unable to pay the fee. There shall be 65 delegates and 6 alternates elected at the State Convention. Only candidates committed to the nomination of the Democratic candidate for President of the United States may serve as Delegate or Alternate.

If the number of candidates for delegate/alternate is equal to or fewer than the total allocated to each presidential candidate per the March 3, 2020, Presidential Primary results in Rappahannock, the Chair shall cancel the caucus and those delegate/alternate candidates who have filed shall be deemed to be elected by the caucus. In the event that fewer than the allocated number pledged to each candidate are elected in the caucus, the delegation members pledged to that candidate shall fill the vacancies.
