- Provide training in the clinical areas of opioid abuse, mental and behavioral health, or childhood obesity.
- One-on-one mentorship and peer to peer mentorship.
- Community engagement and service learning.

Eligibility

- NM resident or Navajo Nation resident/U.S citizen or noncitizens nationals, or foreign who possess a visa permitting permanent residence in the U.S. (for payment purposes only)
- Must express interest in a health profession
- Enrolled in a degree or certificate granting program.
