



Air Force Budget for Fiscal Year 2023 (FY23)

1. TOPLINE \$209.6 BILLION

Operations & Maintenance – \$68.1 billion

Procurement – \$25.7 billion

Personnel – \$39.3 billion

Research, Development, Test & Evaluation (RDT&E) – \$33.4 billion

Military Construction (Air Force and Space Force combined) – \$3 billion

“Non-Blue” Budget (unspecified) – \$40.2 billion

2. RDT&E AND PROCUREMENT GET LARGEST INCREASES

RDT&E – 16% increase over Fiscal Year 2022 (enacted)

Procurement – 12% increase over Fiscal Year 2022 (enacted)

3. “MODEST” REQUEST FOR F-35s

President’s budget requests just 33 airframes – down from the FY22 request for 48 airframes.

4. BUDGET SEEKS REDUCTION OF 238 LEGACY AIRCRAFT

Current Total Aircraft Inventory (TAI) is 5,178

This TAI reduction of 4.5% of **current** inventory is offset by budget request for new airframes.

5. UNFUNDED PRIORITIES LIST

\$4.6 billion

Would raise Air Force topline to \$214.2 billion.
